His faithfulness continues on and I'm looking forward to what 2008 will bring.

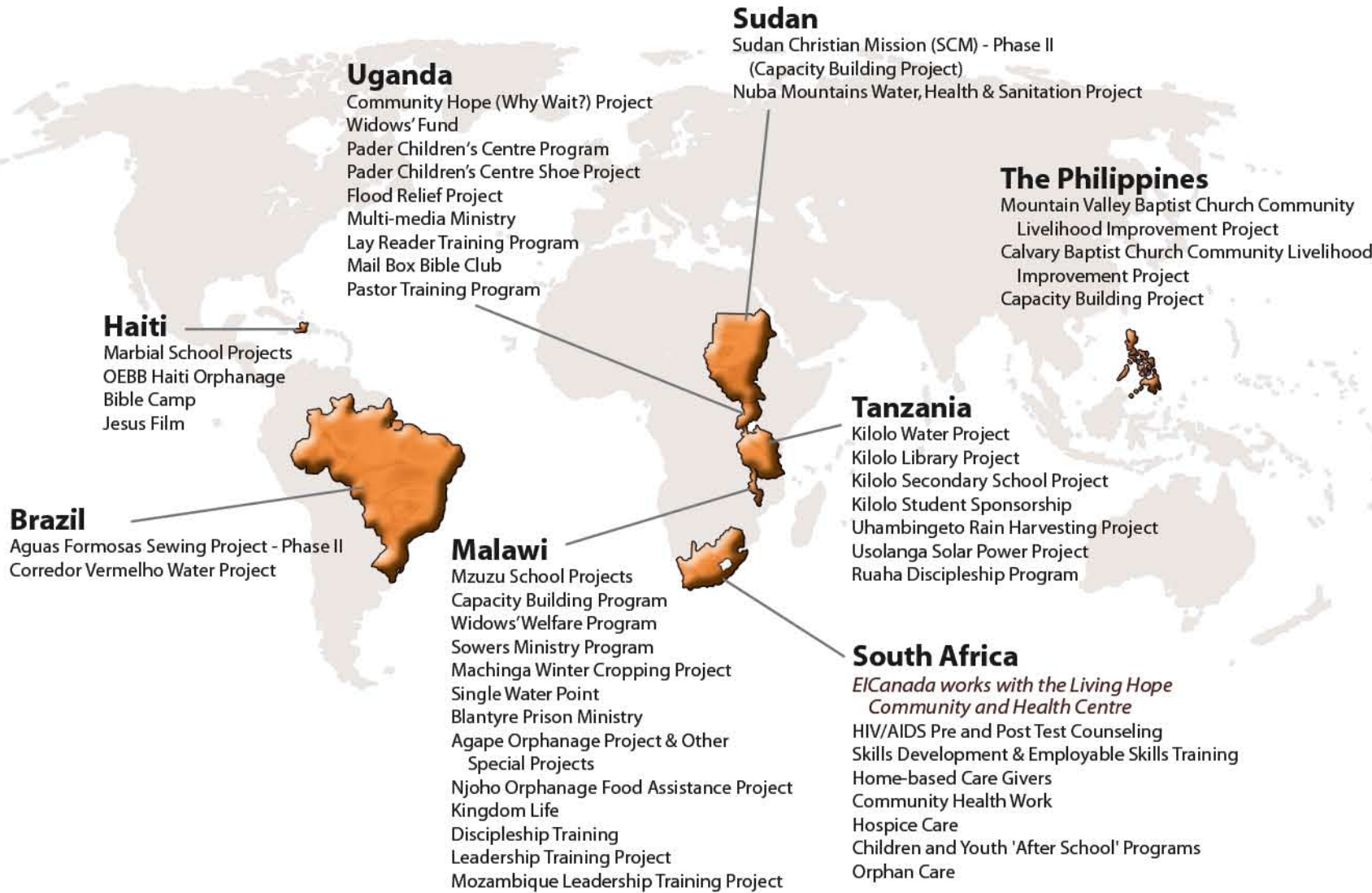

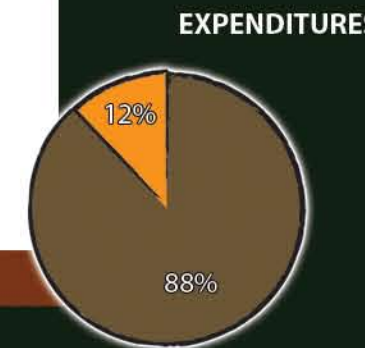
